



Smooth operator

From Andrea Bocelli epics to AC/DC anthems and everything in between, pianist and vocalist Alex Fietz can play it all, writes **Barry Ralph**

OLD Coast piano player and vocalist Alex Fietz prefers to concentrate on dynamics, not decibels. "Amplification should only be necessary for the audience to comfortably hear your performance," he says.

"It should not overwhelm them. Excessive levels of sound can become just noise and rob a performance of its musical value."

One of the most experienced musicians on the local scene, Fietz, 35, has performed thousands of gigs in venues from cruise ships to the world's best hotels.

"I've been playing piano since I was four years old. I studied classical piano, voice and composition for many years," he says.

"This background was a good foundation for my career. I have been playing professionally since 1990."

Fietz is a musician of considerable talent and a consummate performer.

"Any artist has to be able to play for the gig and the occasion," he says. "As a professional musician, you

have to be able to adapt to any audience - or any setting.

"I do it all – from Andrea Bocelli to AC/DC and everything in between. I have 1000 songs in my repertoire. Sometimes I may have to search for the lyrics, but I can play the music for all of them.

"The secret of doing requests is to do them in your own style and not to try and imitate anybody."

Fitz is comfortable with virtually every musical style and genre.

"I play jazz, rhythm and blues, pop, gospel and a little rock. I'm not a specialist in any one of those forms, but I love them all. Call me a lover of music," he says.

Fietz enjoys spontaneity and creativity.

"That's the qualities I like in jazz and the blues," he says.

"Playing them gives you the opportunity to put your personal stamp on the material. In classical music, you are interpreting somebody else's music. There is little opportunity to make an individual statement.

"The opposite is true with jazz.

Fietz hones versatility

V ERSATILE Gold Coast piano player and vocalist Alex Fietz is a performer who prefers delicacy over decibels.

"Amplification should only be necessary for the audience to comfortably hear your performance. It should not overwhelm them," he says.

"I think that the loud volume of sound, which is obvious in a lot of pop music, can restrict your natural ability in using dynamics and nuances."

Fietz, 34, is already a seasoned performer who has played thousands of gigs – from cruise ships to the world's best hotels.

"I've been playing piano since 1 was four years old. I studied classical piano, voice and composition for many years," he says.

"This academic background was a good foundation for my career. I have been playing professionally since 1990." Fietz is a musician of considerable talent, but he has one other quality he feels is essential for success.

"Versatility is the key for any successful performer," he says.

"As a professional musician, you have to be able to adapt to any occasion or any setting. I do it all – from Andrea Bocelli to AC/DC and everything in between. I have 1000 songs in my repertoire.

criman-born Alex Fietz has spent the past 15 years establishing himself as one of the busiest and most popular plano men in Australia. He has successfully brought the sounds

He has successfully brought the sounds of the piano to the fore, taking it from timid background ambience music to grooving, party-starting tunes, with a good dash of soul, R.n'B, Top 40, jazz and rock 'n' roll lavished in between.

'n' roll lavished in between.

From the decks of Bahamas-touring cruise ships, to the lobbies of the world's most prestigious resorts and hotels and even on the snowy slopes of Switzerland, Fietz delivers crowd-pleasing tunes from his 1400-strong repertoire of songs and happily takes requests to foster audience involvement.

But if there's one thing he asks, it is please, please don't request Billy Joel's

Plano Man.

"It's like people asking a guitar man to play Stairway to Hearen," he laughs.

"It's all we're ever asked to play and I think I have played Piano Man at least 4000 times; I play it or am asked to play it every time I perform."

every time I perform."


With the exception of his 'pet hate' — which he will still perform in perfect harmony if asked — Fietz says he has not once become bored with the profession that has supported him from 18 years of age.

Always rearranging his songs, adding impromptu ad-libs and playing around with the delivery of his performance, Fietz has defied the stereotype of piano music being simply a sound to be filtered through the background of an evening.

Fietz is very much in the spotlight when he performs behind his grand instrument, whether that be jamming on the ski slopes, rocking out at Hamilton Island Resort or crooning along at Jennifer Lopez's Still

Fictz has been living his jet-setting, musical dream life for as long as he can remember and shudders at the thought of

doing anything clse with his life. As a young boy who immigrated to Australia from Germany with his parents and sister in 1984, Fietz was determined never to work a normal day job. "I did give it a go when I was 14," he reflect.

he reflects.

work a 'normal' day job.

"I did give it a go when I was 14," he reflects.

"I worked at Dreamworld clearing tables for a while - I lasted all of two weeks before I quit and I have never looked back.

"Music is just so much more fulfilling and rewarding and you meet all kinds of interesting people and can travel to the most amazing places."

For Fietz, his love affair with the ivorymusic-maker begun as an inquisitive three-year-old boy in Germany. His mother brought home a 150-year-old upright piano to be used as antique farniture.

"She put it in the spare room and it wasn't long before I was reaching up on my tippee-toes to touch the keys and that sound ... that sound was magic."

While he was able to touch and hear the keys, Fietz was unable to see them and so it was when he was six-years-old that his parents took him for piano lessons.

By the time the budding musician had reached 12 and had moved to the Gold Coast with his family, music was well and truly flowing through his veins and occupying his mind.

"Until I was 16, 17, I was playing instrumentally before taking singing lessons at 18.

"When you're playing instrumentally, it is just background music, really, but when you start singing, you get much more of a reaction from the audience and you are more involved yourself.

"It is so much more exciting and to sing is easy, but to sing with emotion, that's the trick."

For almost as long as he has been caressing the piano keys, the 33-year-old has also been writing and composing music of his own and, over the past 10 or so years, has been producing and composing ther people's work as well.

The culmination of Fietz's original recordings came together in 2003 with the release of his debut CD, Paradise in your Eyer.

His current residency is at Sea World-Nara Resort, a popular Friday and Satur-

His current residency is at Sea World Nara Resort, a popular Friday and Satur-day night spot that he has held to much delight of guests and visitors since August last year.

With singer Mary-Anne Sterling and guitarist Steve Keeley, Fietz also performs the popular Sounds of Streisand show by appointment.






